We are pleased to inform you that the **IV on-line Europe-Asia Forum on Education** "Sustainable development in our society" will be held on October 30-31, 2021. In the year of 75th Anniversary of UNESCO and as a part of the celebration of the 40th Anniversary of the World Federation of UNESCO Clubs, Centres and Associations (WFUCA), the project will create a platform to overview the important initiatives proclaimed by organization with a focus on the Agenda 2030. The main aim of the Forum is to analyze the interdependence between the natural, social, cultural and economic environment development and prosperity, and share best practices on integrative and inclusive role of education in promoting a sustainable development in our society. Draft concept note is attached for your guidance.

It is important to remind that the first and second Forum in 2013 and 2014 was successfully held in China and in 2015 the third in Romania. This year due to the pandemic by the initiative of Romanian and Kazakhstan Federations the event will be organized in the on-line format with the support of the European and Asian-Pacific Federations of Clubs and Associations for UNESCO and under the auspices of the World Federation of UNESCO Clubs, Centers and Associations in a memory of three leaders Mr. Dhirendra Bhatnagar, Mr. Tao Xiping and Mr. Masatake Matsuda. The Forum will be also held within the celebration of the 20 years of activities of EFUCA.

It is expected that the IV Europe-Asia Forum on Education "Sustainable development in our society" will gather members of the world UNESCO Clubs movement, representatives of UNESCO Headquarters and National Commissions for UNESCO as well as interested participants from the different international organizations, academia and non-governmental sectors. As the result of the event will be published the Conference proceedings in a special digital and hard copy volume.

Taking into consideration the importance of joined efforts to more peaceful and sustainable world, we kindly ask you **to submit nominations for the participation in the Forum by October 8**th, **2021** by completing registration form (enclosed). Please be advised that working language is English and maximum time frame for each speaker is 8-10 minutes.
